National updates

Pharmacy First

- Pharmacy First started on <u>1 January 2024</u>, and we have received feedback from some contractors that there has been some issues with PharmOutcomes access from some pharmacies, as well as surgeries. PharmOutcomes are aware of this issue and have said that anyone who signed up to the Pharmacy First Service via MYS, but missed the 19 January deadline visibility of the service, could not be guaranteed access for 31 January.
- Health Education England are offering community pharmacists and pharmacy technicians a range of fully funded, flexible training to expand your clinical skills and improve patient care. Full details can be found on <u>NHS England site</u>.
- The General Pharmaceutical Council (GPhC) has released advice for pharmacy owners and superintendents on safely implementing pharmacy services following the start of the Pharmacy First Service across England. Full information can be found on the <u>CPE website</u>.

C-19 Vaccinations: NHSE extends contracts until 31 August

 NHS England has written to pharmacies currently providing the COVID-19 vaccination service to ask whether they would be willing to extend the duration of their current contract to provide the service until 31 August 2024. You will need to let your local commissioner know by 22 February 2024 if you are able to continue providing the service. Full details can be found on the <u>CPE website</u>.

Smartcard model changes and rights extension

During the COVID-19 pandemic, the NHS added multi-site 'FFFFF' (5F) codes and SCR (Summary Care Record) rights onto NHS Smartcards with the pharmacist or pharmacy technician role. These rights were due to expire on 31 January 2023, but NHS England has bulk changed pharmacy professionals' Smartcards, to extend these rights until 1 February 2027. Contraception Service

With the new changes to the Contraception Service from 1 December 2023 now including initiation and on-going/repeat supplies, pharmacies who were already signed up to the service providing Tier 1 (on-going/repeat supplies) will have until 11:59pm 29 February 2024, to opt into the new service via their <u>MYS platform</u>. If you choose not to opt in by this deadline you will automatically be deregistered from the service. Further information on the changes to the service can be found on the <u>CPE website</u>.

Recruiting foundation trainee pharmacists in 2024 (2025 intake)

Significant changes have been implemented for the 2025 foundation training year in line with the Initial Education and Training of Pharmacists reform programme required by the General Pharmaceutical Council (GPhC). This means that recruiting via the National Recruitment Scheme (Oriel) will be the only route to employing a foundation trainee pharmacist for the 2025-26 foundation training year.
