### **Briefing Event: Critical Pressures and the future.**

Community Pharmacy England has opened registration for a national event for pharmacy owners as part of an ongoing effort to engage more meaningfully with everyone in the sector. The purpose of the event will be to provide an update across a range of issues impacting pharmacies as well as the wider outlook for community pharmacy and upcoming work.

This event will be held digitally on Tuesday 7 May from 7pm to 8:30pm.

The launch of the BLMK Pharmacy First Service Webinar Series, a local initiative aimed at fostering collaboration and successful implementation of the Pharmacy First Service within primary care networks (PCNs) and community pharmacies in the integrated neighbourhoods.

### PharmOutcomes guide to Pharmacy First.

The PharmOutcomes team have created templates to support all elements of the service. There are 3 key parts to the Pharmacy First service:

- 1. Minor Illness consultation with the pharmacist.
- 2. Urgent medicines supply.
- 3. Clinical pathway consultations supporting the treatment of seven common conditions under a PGD or protocol.

As parts 1 and 2 are referral services only, pharmacy teams will see many similarities with the existing CPCS templates.

#### **GP Connect: Update Record rollout.**

GP Connect: Update record is a feature that CPCF IT system suppliers are adding to their systems.

Update Record allows information about patient consultations outside of general practice to be shared safely with general practice, so the information can be updated in the patient record.
