**Traffic Light Classification for Prescribing** 



**RED:** responsibility for prescribing remains with a hospital consultant or specialist

AMBER: requires shared care between the specialist and the GP. Either Specialist Initiated (SI) or Specialist Recommended (SR).

**GREEN:** routinely prescribed. Some may be Specialist Initiated (SI) or Specialist Recommended (SR).

**DOUBLE RED:** not routinely commissioned. Requires Prior Approval (PA) via <a href="mailto:northantsicb.priorapproval@nhs.net">northantsicb.priorapproval@nhs.net</a> or Individual Funding Request (IFR) to be requested by the clinician recommending the medicine.

GREY: holding category for medicines not yet classified.

#### **Shared Care**



Shared care is undertaken according to <u>NHSE</u> and <u>GMC</u> guidance. In transfer of responsibility, please ensure:

- If a Shared Care Protocol exists, the patient's condition fits the criteria stated.
- Sufficient information is shared.
- The medicine has been classified as AMBER for use across Northamptonshire.

## **Medicines Supply in Secondary Care**



### **Outpatients:**

 Medicines required within 28 days will be supplied by the hospital (28 days will be supplied in most cases).

### Discharge:

 28-days treatment will be supplied except in line with a dispensing for discharge policy (minimum 14 days) or where a shorter duration is clinically indicated.

#### ED attendance:

 14-days treatment will be supplied except where a shorter duration is clinically indicated.
