National Updates

Approach with new Government and strategic planning considered at June Committee Meeting.

Community Pharmacy England reconsidered the immediate priorities for the new Government, alongside wider strategic planning, when members met in Birmingham last month.

Global IT issue impacting some health IT systems.

NHS England issued a communication to highlight the global IT issue which affected multiple IT systems across the world.

If you experience IT issues, pharmacy teams should use the normal reporting routes, which start with contacting your IT supplier.

Where a pharmacy IT system is unavailable, the pharmacy owner will need to activate relevant parts of their business continuity plan.

<u>CPAF screening process – less than two weeks to complete.</u>

Pharmacy owners yet to complete the screening questionnaire are reminded that they have until **midnight on Wednesday 31 July 2024** to complete.

As a result of NHS regulations introduced at the end of 2020, completion of CPAF is now a requirement of the Terms of Service. **Therefore, pharmacy owners must complete the screening questionnaire and, if required, the full CPAF questionnaire**.
