National Updates

GP action: maintaining a safe pharmacy service.

General Practices across England have <u>started to take action</u>, following a ballot of GP partners by the BMA. This means that many practices are 'working to rule', only undertaking tasks that are included in their NHS contract.

Pharmacy owners need to maintain the safety of their services, with the safe supply of medicines being a key priority Pharmacies forced to halt services as pressure continues.

Protest activity across England: impact on pharmacies.

Protests and violent disorder are affecting some towns and cities across England, and this may have an impact on the ability of community pharmacies to operate. If your pharmacy is in an area which is being affected, follow any guidance being provided by the police or local government.

NHSmail multi-factor authentication rolls out for all users.

MFA will soon be mandatory for all NHSmail users. The NHSmail team has announced that users will be prompted to enable MFA from mid-August, and an MFA timeline will be introduced to support the rollout.

Community Pharmacy England and LPCs complete representation changes.

A series of documents have been published by CPE following discussion of many of the key points and themes at regional meetings with pharmacy owners this summer.

NHS England have funded the Centre for Pharmacy Postgraduate Education (CPPE) to offer places on their **Accuracy checking pharmacy technician (ACPT)** programme for pharmacy technicians. The programme is a 3–12-month training and development programme available to pharmacy technicians, with employee support.

Reminders

Flu Vaccination start dates and comms for patients.

The start date for the flu vaccination will be **Thursday 3 October 2024**, with an exception for pregnant women, which is 1 September 2024.

The <u>service specification</u> is clear that the NHS will not pay for vaccinations administered outside of the announced dates for vaccination.

Change to August Pharmacy First monthly threshold.

The Department of Health and Social Care and NHS England, and ministers have now decided that they intend to adjust the **August threshold to 15** in light of the concerns that CPE have raised.
