NHS England Pharmacy First campaign re-start.

NHS England will be relaunching their Pharmacy First campaign on Monday 11 November.

Minor revisions have been made to the original campaign materials used earlier this year, including additional information on the age criteria for the clinical pathways.

Ahead of the official launch, the campaign materials are available on the **Department of Health and Social Care's Campaign Resource Centre website**.

One Year on from Vision: LPCs and wider stakeholders consider the outlook for pharmacy.

LPCs and Community Pharmacy England met with a range of advocates and patient groups last week to reflect on the outlook for the sector a year on from the publication of the <u>Vision for Community Pharmacy</u>.

Conference of LPC representatives 2024.

The Annual Conference of LPC Representatives is an important event in the calendar, giving LPCs the chance to discuss the big issues troubling pharmacy owners in their areas and share ideas and learning.

We had 2 representatives from BLMK-N LPC attend, Has Modi (Committee Member) and Mahesh Shah (Vice Chair).

FAO BLMK - Good Practice Re Colchicine.

Following a critical incident recently, possibly involving colchicine, key points for prescriptions for colchicine are that no prescription should be as directed, this is because there is only a small difference between a correct dose and an overdose and instructions must be clear. Large quantities should be flagged too.

For acute gout:

Prescribe 500 micrograms of colchicine 2-4 times daily, until pain relief is achieved.

The manufacturer recommends a dose of 1 mg to start followed by 500 micrograms after 1 hour, leaving a gap of 12 hours, and resuming treatment with 500 micrograms every 8 hours until symptoms are relieved.

The maximum dose per course is 6 mg (12 tablets) and the course should not be repeated within 3 days.

For prophylaxis of gout flares (during urate-lowering treatment):

Give 500 micrograms of colchicine twice daily following initiation of long-term treatment with allopurinol

Decide treatment duration taking into account factors such as flare frequency, gout duration and the presence and size of tophi – it is for a period of time until the urate lowers, maximum 6 months, often only 3 months.

FAO Bedford/Central Bedfordshire/Milton Keynes - Pharmaceutical Needs Assessment (PNA) Community Pharmacy Survey extended.

The purpose of the PNA is to identify what pharmaceutical services are currently available in an area and where services are likely to be needed in the future, because of changes to the health or demographics of the population. The PNA plays a **crucial** part in supporting commissioning decisions in relation to local pharmaceutical service provision based on patient's needs.
