FAO BLMK - Molnupiravir drug tariff change.

Some of you in BLMK ICB area have been kind enough in the past to keep stock of molnupiravir, an antiviral used to treat Covid 19.

Prior to the 1April 25 molnupiravir was sent to pharmacies **free of charge** from stock centrally procured by the DofH during the pandemic. The free stock all expired on 31 March 2025; all new stock ordered from Alliance will be charged at the list price of **£590** a box.

Fiona Garnett, Associate Director Pharmacy and Medicines Optimisation wishes to bring this to your attention. You should no longer order a box 'just in case' thinking it was still free of charge. Please note the ICB do not expect you to stock this moving forward because the financial loss is significant.

The ICB understands that the Paxlovid all expires in May 2025, and this will move to £829 a box. The ICB will identify 1 or 2 pharmacies to stock a single pack and will underwrite the cost of the pack should it expire before use. The pharmacy or pharmacies are yet to be identified. When we have the information, we will let you know so patients can be signposted correctly and with minimal inconvenience. You may wish to make use of the existing What's App group created for the service previously.

The triage team at MKUC are all aware that if they prescribe Molnupiravir then it will need to be ordered for the patient on receipt of the prescription.

FAO North Northamptonshire - PNA Draft.

CPPE page on PQS updated in light of new CPCF 2025/26.

In light of the new CPCF 2025/26 arrangements CPPE has updated its Pharmacy Quality Scheme webpages and this includes a PQS tracker to help community pharmacy professionals quickly determine which of learning programmes and assessments they have completed within the specified timeframe.

Some of the training requirements within the PQS domains relate to three of CPPE learning programmes/assessments:

- Consulting with people with mental health problems e-learning
- Emergency contraception e-learning and e-assessment
- Early recognition of sepsis e-learning and e-assessment
