Menopause: prescribing perspectives

This workshop is designed so you discuss with colleagues how to meet the needs of people in a consultation to individualise care and considering how to provide medicines safely.

An important part of the workshop is to connect with your peers to build support networks for your ongoing development.

You will have access to a comprehensive e-course to refer back to with details of the evidence base to support your shared and clinical decision making, monitoring and review requirements and how to assess and improve your service. The e-course also provides prescribing conundrums to work through and a portal for sharing information with your colleagues.

Respiratory clinical assessment skills workshop

This all day workshop will introduce you to the essential clinical history taking and examination skills relating to respiratory symptoms. The workshop will be led by experienced GPs and includes clinical scenarios to help apply learning to practice. The workshop is supported by access to the Fundamentals of respiratory therapeutics e-course to support the overall learning.
